Commute PA, the SRTP's Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program, continues to showcase the ability to demonstrate state-of-the-art services for commuters across the region. The SRTP was ushered into elite company in the TDM industry with the receipt of the inaugural Association for Commuter Transportation (ACT) "Accredited TDM Organization" status. Becoming part of the pioneering group of eleven nationwide TDM providers to receive this recognition is a testament to the leadership of the SRTP Board of Directors.

The delivery of the Regional Congestion Management Process "HUB Portal" is a representation of outstanding collaboration between the forward-thinking planning members of the SRTP, and the technical assistance offered by AECOM. This new tool to aid MPO's in the preparation of their CMP's provides cost-saving measures coupled with consistency of data sources across regional boundaries.

The SRTP has successfully created its' own identity with the launch of a new SRTP brand and website. The SRTP was synonymous with "Commuter Services of PA" for most of their first twenty years. The broadening of services being delivered by the Board of Directors allowed this new public-facing image to properly demonstrate the time and effort put forth by this group of leaders from nine south-central PA counties.

As Executive Director of the SRTP, I am honored to have the pleasure of networking with the leaders from our regional MPO's, transit agencies and chambers of commerce, to deliver impactful programming to those traversing our roadways, railways, sidewalks and bike paths.
